Biographical sketch:

William Robert Smith, Jr. (b. Dec. 23, 1900, Colorado City, Texas - d. May 13, 1986, San Antonio, Texas) was an attorney who served as a Representative to the Texas State House and as U.S. Attorney for the Western District of Texas. One of Smith's most notable cases was the prosecution of George B. Parr for tax evasion.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of photocopies of George B. Parr's application for a pardon and a Collier's Magazine article, "Something is Rotten in the State of Texas," pertaining to Parr's political influence in South Texas and the 1948 Texas Democratic Party primary election for the U.S. Senate seat.
