Biographical sketch:

Isabelle Shelton was a journalist who worked for the Chicago Sun, Cincinnati Enquirer, and Washington Star. Shelton worked for a year in 1980 at the Department of Education as an assistant secretary of public affairs with Liz Carpenter. Ms. Shelton also wrote a weekly syndicated column for the North American Newspaper Alliance and did freelance work for various newspapers and magazines.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of newspaper clippings, drafts and tear-sheets of news articles, press releases, notes, background materials, correspondence, reports, transcripts, speeches, and other materials collected by Isabelle Shelton from throughout her 50 year career in journalism. Shelton wrote extensively about First Ladies, White House social events; White House china and furnishings, presidential inaugurations, as well as politics, the courts, civil rights, transportation, and women's issues.
