Biographical sketch:

John Daly Cofer (1898-1971) was an attorney in Texas. He was chief counsel to the U.S. Senate Preparedness Investigating Subcommittee in 1956.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of legal documents, correspondence, and other materials related to the cases Johnson v. Stevenson and Schuille v. Rice, Steakley, et al. The Johnson v. Stevenson case pertains to Lyndon B. Johnson's narrow victory over Coke Stevenson in the 1948 Texas Democratic primary run-off election for the party's nomination for the U. S. Senate seat. The Schuille v. Rice case pertains to Johnson running for Vice-President and Senator at the same time.
