### Biographical sketch:

James Stevenson Covington, Jr., also known as Jim Covington, (b. April 2, 1929, Sulphur Springs, Texas-d. July 11, 2010, Houston, Texas), was a lawyer and a law professor at the University of Houston for many years. He took a leave of absence in 1966-1967 to become the first Chief of the Civil Division of the Houston Legal Foundation, a Great Society program to start neighborhood law offices and facilitate legal services for the poor.

This collection consists of two volumes of memoranda, speeches, notes of meetings, and other documents pertaining to James S. Covington, Jr. and his work as Chief of the Civil Division of the Houston Legal Foundation.
