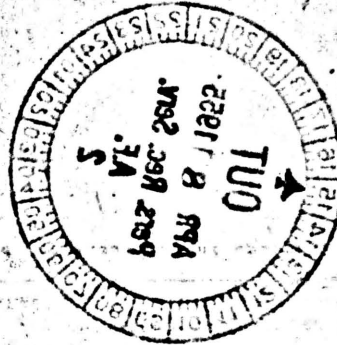

No other person is authorized to apply for or receive a CIL.

Item 3 - Enter grade held at time of relief or discharge from active military service.

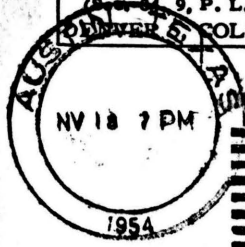



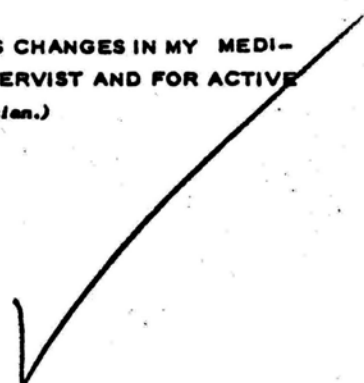

Oaths of office of Air Force officers should be taken before some civil officer who is authorized by the laws of the United States or by the local municipal law to administer oaths or before any commissioned officer of any component (*including the Reserve component*) of any of the Armed Forces of the United States, whether or not on active duty, or before a warrant officer who is serving as the adjutant, assistant adjutant, or personnel adjutant of a command.

4. If the oath is administered by a civil official, the oath must bear the official seal of the person administering the oath, or if he does not use a seal, his official capacity to administer oaths must be certified to under seal by clerk of court or other proper local official.



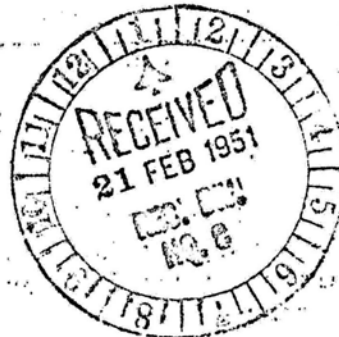
