

1. Reference is made to Voucher No 21728, April 1945, accounts of Lt. Col. A.V. Hashagen, FD, symbol 210-519, on which Captain Walter W. Jenkins, O-1576186, QMC, was paid for the month of March 1945. The copy of the voucher furnished this office for action per AR 35-1360 indicates no deduction for field rations furnished subsequent to 31 January 45.

2. Paragraph 2, Section IV, Circular No 116, Headquarters Mediterranean Theater of Operations, 18 September 1944, provides as follows:

"Officers *** will have deducted on their next pay voucher the sum of seventy-five (75¢) for each day's stay in this theater. However, upon entering or leaving the theater, when less than three meals are consumed, deductions will be made at the rate of twenty-five cents (25¢) for each meal."

3. Section II, Circular No 37, Headquarters Mediterranean Theater of Operations, 8 March 1945, advises that "numerous instances have occurred in the case of officers returned to the United States from this theater *** where they have failed to enter the proper field ration deduction on pay vouchers presented at this theater make certain that they possess proper information for the submission of pay accounts at new stations."

4. It therefor appears that Captain Jenkins is indebted to the United States for twenty-eight (28) field rations furnished in February 1945 and the number actually involved prior to his embarkation on 12 March 1945. Action toward the collection of this indebtedness is requested.
