

On October 7, 1964, while sitting
on a bench in the Southwest
section of Lafayette Park, I
observed a white male walking
toward me from the west. This
white male sat down on the
same bench as I. He struck
up a conversation by asking me
if I came here often. I replied
no. There was other conversation,
the exact words I do not recall.
I believe that he asked if he

hadn't seen me at a specific place, the name of which I do not recall. In fact I had never heard of the place. He told me his name was Walter Jenkins, what was my name. I did not give him mine but instead I gave him ~~some~~^a name that first came to my mind and I cannot recall what it was. I then left. After leaving I wrote the

name Walter Jenkins on a piece of paper I had in my pocket. My reason for doing this was that I thought this person to be strange.

This person appeared to me to be 42-44 yrs, 5 feet 7 to 9 inches 155-165 lbs, Median complexion with some scars on the back of his neck. He wore dark summer glasses and

a dark suit.

On October 12, 1964, and again I
am not sure about the date,
I called ^(phone) the Criminal records
Room, Metropolitan Police. I
identified myself as Sgt. Skosman
of the Park Police. My best
recollection is that the man
that answered stated his
name but I do not remember
what it was. I asked him
to check the name of Walter

Jenkins. He asked if he was white or colored and the age, I replied that he was white, about 42-44 yrs, and I did not

have any further information. I believe I told him I thought he was queer, after a pause he returned

and stated they had more ~~than~~ ^{than} one Walter Jenkins,

could it be Walter Wilson Jenkins. I ^{believe I} told him I didn't know, ^{and asked} what kind of record does he have. Information on the

A Negro Policeman behind the counter took the form and after checking the files stated that he had no record. After rechecking, a white Policeman sitting at a desk near the counter asked if there was a charge out card in the file. The ^{Negro} ~~Police~~ Policeman stated no.

The white Policeman then found the file laying on his desk and stated that someone else had already checked it. I was shown the record and it contained two arrests for disorderly conduct. I asked for Anne's name a photostatic copy of the record. I put the record in my pocket and left the Building. I did not check any other files or records, nor make any inquiries.

I did not show or give this information to anyone.

My first knowledge of the importance of this matter was gained at ~~the~~ about 6:00 P.M. Oct 14/1966 when I heard a TV newscast that Walter Jenkins, Top Aide to President Johnson was in the Hospital. Prior to this time I had no idea who Walter Jenkins was.

The slip of paper that I wrote the original notation of Walter Jenkins on was destroyed by me. The photostat was retained by me and in my possession at all times. The only time ^{that} it was shown to anyone by me was on Oct. 16, 1964. At this time it was shown to F.B.I. Special Agent Cal Force, at his request. Force requested the

record and I turned it
over to him.

NAB COLONEL IN MORALS CASE

Washington, D. C.

An Army Lieutenant Colonel with some White House liaison functions has been hospitalized after arrest here on a morals charge similar to that involved in the Walter Jenkins affair.

It was learned Wednesday that the 42-year old officer was assigned to the personal staff of Secretary of the Army Stephen Ailes.

October 6 Arrest

Records at the District of Columbia Metropolitan Police Department show that the officer was arrested on October 6 at 9:10 P.M. -- less than 24 hours before the arrest of Jenkins. The man was charged with disorderly conduct (loitering) and posted a \$25.00 bond, which he forfeited.

The Police Department records state that he was in the YMCA at 1736 - G - Street, N. W., where he engaged in conversation with a Morals Squad detective, L. P. Drouillard, and suggested that they go for a ride. Later, Morals Squad Lt. Louis A. Fochett drove up where the Army Lt. and Drouillard were parked on a side street near the Lincoln Memorial and two Morals Squad detectives made the arrest.
