Creator: Hardeman, D. Barnard, Jr., 1914-1981

Biographical sketch:

D. Barnard Hardeman, Jr., (b. August 16, 1914, Goliad, Texas-d. December 3, 1981, San Antonio, Texas), Texas politician, political scholar, journalist and teacher. He graduated from the University of Texas and the University of Texas Law School and served in the U.S. Army during World War II. He served in the 52nd and 54th Legislatures representing Grayson and Collin counties in the Texas House of Representatives. Between 1958 and 1961, he worked as an assistant to Sam Rayburn, U.S. Speaker of the House, and was Rayburn's official biographer. An avid bibliophile whose book collection numbered more than ten thousand volumes, Hardeman bequeathed his collection of American biographies and political history to the Lyndon B. Johnson Presidential Library in Austin, Texas.

Scope and content note:

This collection contains personal and office files maintained by D. B. Hardeman during the span of his life. It pertains to Hardeman's work as the Texas director of organization for Adlai Stevenson's presidential campaign and his work as an advisor and advance man for Lyndon B. Johnson's campaign for vice president; as assistant to Sam Rayburn, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and Majority Whip, Hale Boggs; his terms as Texas State Representative; and his teaching positions at Trinity College in Washington, D.C., Incarnate Word College, Our Lady of the Lake University, and the University of Texas in San Antonio, Texas. Much of this material covers Texas and national politics; local and national government policy, legislation and legislative procedures; national education policy and the teaching of political science; and the Democratic and Republican parties. There is also some correspondence between Hardeman and his long-time friend, Maury Maverick. The collection consists of correspondence, memorandums, bibliographies, and stationery; manuscripts; appointment books and planners; expense and finance ledgers; lists, notes, and other research material; diaries; speeches and clippings; reports, publications, and other periodicals; bulletins, programs, and brochures; and photographs.
