Creator: Bunker, Ellsworth, 1894-1984

Biographical sketch:

Ellsworth Bunker was an American businessman and diplomat (including being the ambassador to Argentina, Italy, India, Nepal and South Vietnam). He is perhaps best known for being a hawk on the war in Vietnam and Southeast Asia during the 1960s and 1970s.

Scope and content note:

This collection pertains to the career of Ellsworth Bunker in the cane sugar industry followed by his transition to diplomatic service. It consists of materials describing Bunker's activities as president of the National Sugar Refining Company, his chairmanship of the War Production Board's cane sugar advisory committee during World War II, and his activities on the board of National Sugar. This series also describes Bunker's roles as Ambassador to Argentina and Italy under Harry S. Truman, President of the American Red Cross, Ambassador to India and Nepal under Dwight D. Eisenhower, U.S. mediator in the New York Agreement on Western New Guinea negotiated between the Netherlands and Indonesia, U.S. Ambassador to the Organization of American States under Lyndon B Johnson, and Ambassador to South Vietnam under Johnson and Richard M. Nixon. Some material describes Bunker's work on the Terrijos-Carter Treaties that transferred possession of the Panama Canal back to Panama under Jimmy Carter. The collection contains correspondence, reports, memorandums, telegrams, brochures, pamphlets, clippings, articles, speeches, greeting cards, appointment books, biographies, invitations, itineraries, agenda, and photographs.
