Biographical sketch:

Vicente Trevino Ximenes was a Mexican-American civil rights leader who served as Chairman of President Lyndon B. Johnson's Cabinet Committee on Mexican American Affairs. President Johnson also appointed Ximenes as U.S. commissioner of the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, where he served for five years.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of materials pertaining to Vicente Ximenes' activities as Chairman of President Lyndon Johnson's Cabinet Committee on Mexican American Affairs from 1967-1969, along with other materials that pre and postdate his work on the Mexican Affairs Committee. Included are meeting minutes and meeting notes, speech transcripts, correspondence, press releases, certificates, photographs, and publications. The series also includes material from Ximenes' aid work in Panama and Ecuador and his work in the United States as a leading civil rights activist and scholar. These materials include personal letters, newspapers clippings, legal documents from a redistricting case, biographical publications, and awards presented to Ximenes.
