Biographical sketch:

William Womack Heath served as county attorney and county judge of Grimes County, Texas. He was Secretary of State of Texas from 1933 to 1935, and from 1967 to 1969, served as the U.S. Ambassador to Sweden.

Scope and content note:

This collection contains letters, correspondence, greeting cards, diaries, lists, schedules, transcripts, speeches, press releases, certificates, invitations, photographs, clippings, and printed material collected by William Womack Heath. The subjects in the series reflect Heath's professional activities and include travel, the ambassador's residence, the American Embassy in Stockholm, the Nobel Prize, Sweden, Texas, and the University of Texas.
