Tuesday, September 7	Mrs. Johnson goes to Jackson Hole, Wyoming for a speech to a joint meeting of the National Council of State Garden Clubs and the American Forestry Association at Jackson Lake Lodge.
Monday, September 13 6:30 p.m.	Mrs. Johnson attends the Women's National Press Club 1965-66 Inaugural Reception-- Diplomatic Function Area of the Department of State
Friday, September 17 3:00 p.m.	Mrs. Johnson will give a reception in connection with the James Smithson Bicentennial Celebration for approximately 1500 guests.
Tuesday, September 21	Two-day beautification trip: Mrs. Johnson goes to Milwaukee to present award to the American Institute of Park Executives, and for the dedication of the Horticultural Conservatory Domes in Mitchell Park. Mrs. Johnson will also make a tour of the Boerner Botanical Gardens in Milwaukee.
Wednesday, September 22	Mrs. Johnson goes from Milwaukee to Peoria, Illinois to dedicate a new Courthouse and County Building, heart of a downtown beautification development.
Wednesday, September 29 6:00 p.m.	Ballet by the Harkness Ballet Company of New York at the White House to dedicate the new stage for the East Room.
Friday, October 1	Mrs. Johnson goes to Buffalo, New York to make a luncheon address to the Associated Press Managing Editors on the subject of beautification.
