**SCHEDULE FOR MRS. LYNDON B. JOHNSON'S VISIT
TO OMAHA AND LINCOLN, NEBRASKA -- JUNE 15, 1966**

7:45 a.m. EDT Press check in -- MATS Terminal, National Airport

**8:15 a.m. EDT Mrs. Johnson and party depart from Washington
National Airport for Omaha, Nebraska via chartered
jetstar. Full breakfast served on board.**

**8:45 a.m. CST Arrival at Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska. Mrs.
Johnson will be met by Colonel William Reynolds,
Base Commander of Offutt and by Lt. General Joseph
J. Nazzaro, Vice Commander-in-Chief of Strategic
Air Command. Governor Frank Morrison and Mrs.
Morrison, and Omaha Mayor A. V. Sorensen and
Mrs. Sorensen will greet the First Lady as well.**

**Immediately upon her arrival, Mrs. Johnson will
be given a brief driving tour of two beautification
points of Offutt by Col. Reynolds:**

**1. "Old Fort Crook" area of Offutt. Built in
1896, Offutt AFB was originally an Army base,
Ft. Crook, named in honor of General George
Crook, Indian fighter and Civil War hero. Mrs.
Johnson will see the old parade ground area,
around which Officers' quarters and enlisted
quarters and former Army Headquarters building
are still preserved. Renovated on the inside, all
buildings in this area retain their original exterior
appearance, and Officers' quarters and enlisted
quarters are used in the original manner today.
Evidence of early thought and planning is evident
in the profusion of enormous shade trees abundant
along the streets.**

**2. Strategic Aerospace Museum. Dedicated on
Armed Forces Day this year, the 10-acre museum site
displays missiles and aircraft used by SAC in its
20-year history. The citizens of greater Omaha
are planning to construct a building to house smaller
displays and present it to the base -- an example
of cooperation between city and military. Mrs.
Johnson will also be shown where extensive planting
will be made on the museum site.**

Following the tour, the First Lady will go directly to the lawn in front of SAC Headquarters, where official welcoming ceremonies will take place.

Program for ceremony: Remarks by Colonel Reynolds, Lt. General Nazzaro, Mayor Sorensen and Governor Morrison.

Response by Mrs. Johnson

Following the ceremony, Mrs. Johnson will plant a two-year old seedling from the John Quincy Adams elm on the White House grounds in front of the SAC Headquarters Building.

NOTE: Western Union runners available at Offutt Air Force Base. A wire car and another press car will be available for transportation for Washington press throughout the day. An open car will also be available for a photographers' pool during the day.

9:30 a.m. Mrs. Johnson and party depart Offutt Air Force Base.

9:50 a.m. Mrs. Johnson arrives at Assembly Hall in downtown Omaha for meeting with Omaha city employees, representatives of the city of Omaha, Omaha Beautification Committee and Neighborhood Council on "Operation Alert." This project, initiated by Mayor Sorensen, involves all city employees and city residents in reporting beautification needs of the city to the Mayor's office, which follows up on all suggestions.

10:45 a.m. Mrs. Johnson and party arrive at Boys Town. Upon her arrival, the First Lady will be met by the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Nicholas H. Wegner, Director of Boys Town. She will first be given a tour of the grounds by Msgr. Wegner.

Following her tour, Mrs. Johnson will be made an honorary citizen of Boys Town by the boys in an outdoor ceremony in front of the auditorium.

11:15 a.m.

Mrs. Johnson and party depart Boys Town for Lincoln, Nebraska.

12 noon

Mrs. Johnson arrives at Governor's Mansion in Lincoln.

Members of the press go to the Cornhusker Hotel, where State Suite 1 has been set aside as a press room. Phones and Western Union facilities available.

12:30 p.m.

Mrs. Johnson arrives at Cornhusker Hotel for luncheon meeting of Governor's Conference on Natural Beauty in Ballroom. The meeting is part of a day-long session of the Governor's Conference, sponsored by the Governor's Council to Keep Nebraska Beautiful.

1:30 p.m.

Remarks by Governor Morrison and introduction of Mrs. Johnson

2:00 p.m.

Mrs. Johnson and Governor Morrison greet delegates to the Governor's Conference following lunch.

2:30 p.m.

Mrs. Johnson departs Cornhusker Hotel for private visit with Governor and Mrs. Morrison at the Governor's Mansion.

4:45 p.m.

Press departs Cornhusker Hotel

Mrs. Johnson and Governor and Mrs. Morrison depart Governor's Mansion
