Sandwich. Took nap on bed before Tulsa, and while on ground and got up just before landing in <sup>Calif.</sup> (4:20 Refueled in Tulsa)	
⑤	4:00	Arrived Hamilton Airforce Base, California. <sup>500</sup> 300 people waiting. Governor Brown welcomed--brief response.
