	7:30	Coffee & breakfast. Hairdresser in. Signed mail.
	9:00	Left Hotel with Mrs. Holt, Mrs. Waller & Anne Clark.
	9:10	Arrived National Capital Development Commission Kiosk, Regatta Point. Met by Minister for Interior & Mrs. Anthony. CTJ made remarks & planted an Arizona Cypress. Walked thru Kiosk.
	9:40	Arrived pier & board "Marlee" & cruised lake (man-made)
	10:20	Arrived Yarralumla Pier & disembarked. Got in cars & drove to the Prime Minister's Lodge. Coffee, rest, & toured grounds looking at animals
	11:10	Left Lodge with Anne Clark for <del>Hotel</del> American Embassy. Planted a tree on lawn where Mrs. Roosevelt & Hale Boggs had also planted one.
	12:00	Arrived Parliament House & joined President for luncheon.
	2:40	Left Parliament House with the President in motorcade. CTJ rode with Mrs. Holt & Mrs. Clark.
	3:00	Arrived airport & departed Canberra w/ President, P.M. & Mrs. Holt, Amb & Mrs. Clark, Amb & Mrs. Waller, Amb. Symington, Gov. Bryant, Jake & Marvin.

		<p>Sat in stateroom &amp; Pres. opened package. Went to Bedroom with Mrs. Holt, but left when the Pres. came in to take nap.</p> <p>3:55 Arrived Melbourne. It was a gray, cool day with medium sized crowd. Met by Premier of Victoria &amp; Lady Bolte. CTJ received bouquet from Robin Yeo (Tr. Logatee-age 14). Then met city officials</p> <p>4:05 Departed airport in motorcade w/ Mrs. Holt &amp; Mrs. Clark. During one of the many stops, got out &amp; went into Pres. car. Lots of school children in uniforms waving flags - Beagle Club of Victoria - confetti thrown - on main street there were banners in red, white &amp; blue spelling out LBJ. People 30-40 deep going wild. The motorcade was practically frozen by people. Arrived at Dame Mabel &amp; Sir Norman Brooks for brief stop - exchanged gifts. CTJ upstairs to change clothes. Dame Mabel always wears pearls.</p> <p>6:12 Departed Brooks residence. Just before arriving at Government House, 2 boys - about 18 &amp; 21 - hurled plastic bags of green &amp; red paint at the President's car. It hit the front windshield &amp; went over top of car - but windows were closed, so Pres &amp; CTJ were not touched.</p>

	11:20	Arrived Rex Hotel. Large crowd with many cheers & applause.
