	5:20	Coffee. Dress & hair comb. (Red Dress)
①	6:25	Walk around grounds
	7:10	Depart in motorcade for airport. Streets lined with children waving flags.
	8:00	Arrive airport. To Reception Room to say farewell to dignitaries.
	8:20	Wheels up. Went to room to sleep.
	(convert to local time)	
②	9:45	Arrive Kuala Lumpur. Greeted by King & Queen. 4 gold umbrellas. Little girl presented flowers. 21 gun salute as we walked to stand, shaking hands with dignitaries. Speeches.
③	10:20	Leave airport in motorcade <u>Perhentian</u>
	11:00	Arrive Guest House. Rest on bed
④	12:20	Leave to join President at Palace for audience with King & Queen.
	12:45	Luncheon with President & King & Queen in the Palace.
	2:20	Return to Guest House. (Pres. went to rubber plantation)
	2:30	Rest on bed.
⑤	4:15	Leave with Mrs. Bell & Toh Puan Norashikin (wife of the Minister of Home Affairs)
	4:20	Arrive <u>Mosque</u> . Met by Tan Sri Abdul, Chairman of Mosque; Chief Imam; & officials. Take shoes off & walk up stairs. Walk through colonnaded porticoes & into Prayer Room - go to High Altar. Chief Architect, Enche Baharuddin, explained wall inscriptions, etc. Sign Guest book. Received 2 brochures from Chief Imam. See Mausoleum.
	4:45	Leave Mosque with motorcade.

Entry No.	Time	Activity
⑥	4:55	Arrive <u>National Museum</u> . Met by Director Enche Shahrum bin Yub. Half-way up steps, Director's 7 year-old daughter, Yesmin, presents basket of orchids. At head of steps, met Museum Curators. Saw figure, The Pedang, in center of foyer. Walked in Exhibit Hall - FIRST, looked at Malayan shadow puppets (Director gave CTJ two) Then, displays of Chinese Classical Dancers, Sedan Chairs, Bed, model of Chinese House, Headdresses, Circumcision Ceremony, then, back to Foyer & gave brief statement for Press. Commented on being pleased that spaciousness & green areas are being preserved - the outstanding new buildings - the plans for improvements in the Villages. Then, went to see anti-facts -- prehistoric rock shelter, metallurgy.
⑦	5:20	Departed Museum & drove through Lake Gardens. Saw children playing & then crowds of people, waving flags crowded around the car. Stopped to take pictures of Parliament House.
	5:40	Returned Guest House.
	5:50	Look at paintings in room at Guest House & then walked around yard, taking pictures.
	6:20	To room - facial & manicure.
	8:00	Pres. came in room & wanted to show paintings to CTJ.
⑧	8:20	Leave with President for Parliament House
	8:40	Arrive Parliament House. 9 silver trumpets played ruffles & flourishes as we got out. Met by P.M.'s wife, Dep. P.M.'s wife. Went upstairs to Drawing Room for exchange of gifts. (Received Hassan painting of 2 women in street) Downstairs to Banquet Hall. Classical Malaysian Dancers, during Dinner. P.M. toasted Pres. - witty speech about the large bed. Pres. toasted King - said China should increase bread output instead of atomic bombs & then she will be friends with the world.
	10:45	Depart Parliament House
	11:00	Arrive Guest House & to bed!
