	10:55	First Lady and guests returned to new park site for further inspection.

②	2:15	Lunch for 18 persons, including Mr. & Mrs. P.J. Nugent, <i>Mr. Krueger</i> & Mrs. John Ben Shepperd, J.C. Kellam, Judge A.W. Moursund, Will Odom, Charles Krueger (Nat'l. Park Svc.), Douglas Hubbard (Nat'l. Park Svc.), Roy White (architect from Austin).
	2:55	First Lady with President and guests departed in separate cars to tour ranches and inspect new park site.
	5:20	Returned to house.
	6:50	Dinner. Guests included: Mr. & Mrs. P.J. Nugent, <u>Mr. Hubbard</u> , <u>Mr. Krueger</u> , J.C. Kellam, Jake Jacobsen (legal counsel to President), Jim Jones, Marie Fehmer, Mary Slater. The President was out of the room during most of the meal. Mr. Krueger was seated on Mrs. Johnson's right; Mr. Hubbard on her left; they discussed plans for the new park.
	7:31	The President left the house after telling Mrs. Johnson good-bye. <i>(He returned to Washington.)</i>
	12:00 (Midnight)	First Lady in residence at LBJ Ranch with Luci.
