	3:00	To dining room to join President, Doug Cater, Joe Califano, Tom Johnson, George Christian, Ashton -- talked about Civil Rights reception.
	4:05	Left via auto for drive up New York Avenue to look at beautification project. Paper scattered all around.
	4:30	Returned to White House.
	4:45	Cong/M Mahon in to play bridge -- Lynda also.
	6:40	M/M Califano (2 children, too) to Second Floor.
	7:05	M/M Deason to Second Floor.
	7:10	With the President and guests to see dog run. Then to the President's office and to West Wing to inspect First Floor offices.
	7:30	Califano children left. To Bowling Alley (one game) with President and guests.
	8:40	All to Second Floor.
	9:25	Dinner with the President and guests.
