①	8-9	Coffee & juice; bathed and dressed. Looked over the Oak Grove area. Beautician in for comb-out; took the Tony Taylors a guest list. Dressed for the barbeque (white skirt, red & white blouse).
②	12:31	With the President, Luci, M/M Tony Taylor and Amb. Symington, to the Front Yard to receive guests.
	12:58	To the fence for pictures.
	1:04	With the President and Luci, walk toward the river for another picture
	1:16	Return to the Main House. Cutter & return for barbeque
③	1:29	Departed with the guests in school busses to tour ranches.
④	2:00-	To the Oak Grove for barbeque. Spoke with each ambassador individually. Sat
	4:05	across the table from Governor Connally.
	2:55	The President made welcoming remarks, followed by Cactus Pryor. Then came the "Texas Jandangle," the story of the settlement of the West: Indians, Conquistadores, religious monks, pioneers. Directed and produced by Mr. R. N. Nail, with a cast of amateurs.
	3:15	Make speech to thank entertainers.
	3:30	Remarks by the President, Senator Tower, Cong. Gonzales, Cong. De la Garza, Cong. Jake Pickle, Governor Connally. & Nellie & I return to the house
	3:55	All Ambassadors and guests left for San Antonio.
④	4:05	To the house with the President for a nap.
