	4:08	Tea in the West Hall with five Ambassadors' wives. (Mrs. Douglas MacArthur, Mrs. William W. Heath, Mrs. Karl F. Rolvaag, Mrs. Richard H. Nolte, and Mrs. Herbert B. Powell.)
	5:00	Went to the First Floor to greet Mrs. James C. Davis from Georgia and her friends Mrs. Boyd, Mrs. Garland, and her son-in-law, Edward Bowen. They had already started to leave the White House before we arrived to greet them, since they weren't sure that CTJ would be able to see them. After a few minutes of visiting, we went to the Second Floor.
