	3:35	Left the Dining Room to meet with Jim Ketchum and Mr. West in the West Hall Discussed the forthcoming meeting of the Committee for the Preservation of the White House (April 25th) and proposed pictures to add to the White House collection: "Crossing the River Platte" by Whittridge, Vanderlyn's portrait of Madison, and a Tait landscape (vivid colors -- hunter and slain deer).
