	12:10	Returned to the White House -- Second Floor. Had lunch with Marny Clifford.
	1:35	Departed the White House with Mrs. Clifford.
③	2:40	Arrived at the James Monroe Law Office, Fredericksburg, Va. Toured the law office with the owner, Mr. Hoes, and was greeted by Mayor M Rowe and their three children. Then, With Mr. Hoes, Marny, and Mr. Hoes' granddaughter, toured Mary Washington's home and the Kenmore Estate.

	5:40	Returned to the White House.
