	8:15	Breakfast. Watched some of Chancellor Adenauer's funeral on television (via Satellite) Set up the Yellow Oval Room for 10:00AM meeting; she visited briefly with Mrs. George Brown in the Queens' Room -- discussed hanging a new chandelier there.
①	10:00	Meeting of the Committee for the Preservation of the White House. Present were: George Hartzog, John Walker, Bill Walton, J.B. West, Jim Ketchum, Jim Fosburgh, Henry F. duPont, Alice Brown, Mrs. Miller, Liz, Cjt.
	11:55	End of meeting; returned to room to work.
②	12:45	Left the White House for the Senate Ladies' Luncheon at the Capitol: was met by Mrs. Pell, Mrs. Case, and Mrs. Humphrey. <i>yellow Ben Zuckerman</i>
	3:05	Returned to the White House.
③	3:35	Left the White House again, to tour beautification sites with Bob Knudsen. Made brief stops at Hains Point, Mellon Fountain to pose for pictures.
	4:30	Returned to the White House.
④	5:55	To the Green Room to greet Justice M Black and Chief Justice M Warren.
	6:05	With the above guests, went to the Blue Room to receive other guests -- reception to honor Justice Black.
	6:30	To the State Dining Room for refreshments. The Vice President arrived a few minutes later and addressed the group.
