| ② | 11:30 | Minutes after a heavy downpour, went with the President to the South Lawn to welcome Vice President and Mrs. Yen of Nationalist China. Wore bright red coat. The weather was damp and cool, but no rain for the ceremony! |
| | 11:55 | The President went to his office for talks with Vice President Yen; Cj to Second Floor. |
| ③ | 12:58 | The President and Vice President Yen to the Yellow Oval Room, followed shortly by Mrs. Yen and Mrs. Rusk. |
| | 1:25 | With the President and the honored guests, down the Grand Staircase for photos, then to the East Room to receive luncheon guests (142). |
| | 1:40 | To the State Dining Room for lunch, followed by toasts and mingling in the parlors. |
| | 2:45 | With the President, to the North Portico to bid good-bye to the honored guests. |
| | 2:50 | Returned to the Second Floor. |
| ④ | 3:00 | Fitting with Adele Simpson and Mrs. Moseley (fitter); pale yellow chiffon, gold lame. |
| ⑤ | 4:05 | To the Green Room to have tea with Christine Stugard, Lucy Ferguson and their staffs. Talked about Luci's new house, life in Austin, some general chit-chat and discussion of problems in mail handling. Then proceeded to the theatre |

| | 7:15 | With the President, went to the Washington Hilton for the Democratic Campaign Committee fund-raising dinner at which the President spoke about the need to continue working together toward the party's goals in the face of opposition. |
| | 10:20 | Returned to the White House. |
| | 10:30 | The Daleys returned; M/M joined Cjt and the President for a night cap and the children went directly to their rooms on the Third Floor. |
