	9:15	Breakfast. To the President's room.
	10:45	Visit Mrs. Clark in #303.
	11:45	Went to see Dr. Turchin; en route back, stopped at Jean-Louis' for a comb/out.
	1:10	Returned to the White House; on the way to the Second Floor, stopped in the East Room to greet 16 ladies (wives of International Air Transport Ass'n.) on tour.
	1:20	To the Second Floor -- changed into green dress for 2:00 reception; worked at desk and had a glass of milk.
	2:10	To the Blue Room to receive 130 girls from area high schools -- then mixed and mingled with them in the State Dining Room. Refreshments.
	3:00	To the South Grounds for concert by the National Symphony -- joined the President and Lynda on the bandstand -- made welcoming remarks to the 800 students assembled on the lawn (sound amplifiers not working during first part of remarks). After the concert, mixed and mingled with students on the lawn -- signed numerous autographs -- had refreshments at pavillions on lawn.
	4:50	To the Second Floor -- worked with Ashton at desk.
	5:57	To Blair House for donation of Steinway piano.
	6:41	Returned to the Second Floor.
