	8:00	Breakfast. To the President's room.
	9:50	Left the White House with Sharon Francis, Polly Shackleton, and Emma Long.
	10:03	Met Liz at the Neighborhood Museum at Nichols Avenue -- saw vest pocket park the Trailblazers had designed and built next door to the museum -- asked them many questions about their project. Then went into the Museum, and saw the curtains (window and stage) that the girls had made.
	10:34	Arrived at the Frederick Douglas Home -- the Trailblazers have made a picnic area, and are building picnic tables and benches -- I drove a nail into one of the benches -- no speeches, just informal conversations.
	11:06	Left the Douglas home to drive out Penna. Ave. SE, Syphax School, and 3rd & Independence Avenues to show Emma & Polly "beautification in action."
	11:44	Returned to the White House. -
	12:05	Went to Jean-Louis' shop for comb-out.
	12:51	Returned to the White House. Worked with Liz.
	1:58	With the President to the North Portico to greet President M Houphouet-Boigny of the Ivory Coast. Receiving line in the East Room.
	2:10	To the State Dining Room for luncheon.

	3:47	Returned to the Second Floor, riding in the elevator with all of the house guests. Worked with Ashton.

		Worked with Ashton; then met Dr. Willis Hurst on the Truman Balcony.
	6:36	Went Bowling with Dr. Hurst. (2 games)
	7:15	Returned to the Second Floor.
		To the Truman Balcony for refreshments alone.
	10:15	Dinner with the President, George Christion, and Tom Johnson.
