②	12:08	<i>Left with Liz &amp; Cynthia -- stopped at a roadside picnic spot to have the lunch the Sawyers had packed. Stopped also in Litchfield, Mass. to read most of the historical markers -- re Harriet Beecher Stowe, etc.</i>
③	3:00	<i>Arrived at Yale -- at President Brewster's residence. Met with the Brewsters, Liz &amp; Simone -- discussed pickets. Rested; changed clothes and had hair combed.</i>
	5:49	<i>Left the Brewsters' residence; encountered pickets. In the car were the Brewsters, John J. O'Leary (president of the Student Political Union), Liz &amp; Cynthia. Went to the War Memorial Hall (Freshman Commons); dinner inside. I spoke at about 7:00 -- received a standing ovation.
