	12:15	Returned to the Second Floor. Saw Mr. Frame from the Carpenters' Shop re new frames for pictures at the Ranch.
④	12:55	Lunch on tray in room with Lynda (lamb chops & spinach). (Lynda met the ladies of the press at 1:00.)
