	1:07	Returned to the White House.	
③		Lunch in the Solarium with Lynda, Chuck, Tony & Matianna. Visited with house guests on the Third Floor. Rested -- worked on guest lists.	
④	3:15	Had tea in the Lincoln Sitting Room with Mrs. Jacob Hershey, M/M Fleetwood Richards, Dr/M E. T. Ximinez. Afterward, I showed them around the Second Floor -- then turned them over to a guide to complete their tour.	
	4:15	Left the White House -- to Jean-Louis' shop for shampoo & set.	
⑤	7:00	Returned to the White House. Reviewed Mexico info with Ashton. Made phone calls re meeting of the Committee for the Preservation of the White House.	
⑥	8:10	To the North Portico with the President to greet Pres/M Diaz Ordaz and their party. To the Yellow Oval Room to exchange gifts.
