	1:30	Lunch with Liz and Flewine -- chicken & rice soup, roast beef, string beans, green salad). Frances Lewine left. Worked with Ashton.
	3:00	Joined Mr. John Walker in the West Hall -- Mr. West came in a few minutes later -- I went with them, wheeling Charles Russell's "Meat for Wild Men" (bronze) around to find the best place to display it.
