7:15		The President and Mrs. Sanchez to the Ambassador's residence to meet with us -- Amb/M Duke were there, also Jim Jones. Okie, and Don Barnes (interpreter). We chatted briefly inside while the other Central American Presidents and their wives formed escort parade outside.
7:20		Left the residence with Luci and Mrs. Sanchez --motorcade to the airport, passing enthusiastic crowds en route.
7:55		Left El Salvador in Air Force One, with the President, Luci, and ODEA presidents and First Ladies.
8:55		Arrived Managua Airport, Nicaragua for welcoming ceremonies. It was raining -- in spite of that, there was a large, enthusiastic crowd.
9:09		After official ceremony outside, went inside for reception and receiving line (200). The President/m Somoza of Nicaragua and their children gave us 2 hammocks, 2 sets of coins, a rosary and a hand-tooled leather briefcase.
10:00		Left Nicaragua in the rain.
10:48		Arrived in San Jose Costa Rica -- welcoming ceremonies with Pres/M Trejos on platform. Hot & humid -- enthusiastic crowds. After a receiving line outside, went upstairs for exchange of gifts.
Noon		Left Costa Rica.

	1:10	Arrived San Pedro Sula, Honduras -- welcomed in ceremony by Pres/M Arrellano. Hot & Humid. The President made some remarks -- so did Luci and was very warmly received.
	1:45	Went inside the airport for reception and receiving line. The President bought two stools with leather seats for the Ranch.
	2:15	Left Honduras.
	2:55	Arrived in Guatemala City -- very pleasant weather, warm crowds. Welcoming ceremonies by Pres/M Mendez. Viewed native art objects on display in terminal building.
	3:55	Left Guatemala.
		Rested.
		Talked with the President, Marie, Tom Johnson and Jim Jones in the bedroom.
	7:40 CST	Arrived at the Ranch, after transferring from AF One to Jetstar at Randolph. It was raining. Changed clothes inside and visited with Lynda & Lyn.
	8:42	Went for ride with the President, Marie, and Mary. The President talked about fine points in cattle -- how to tell how old they were, etc. Looked over park area and stopped to talk with residents nearby.
	9:19	Returned to the house.
	10:00	Dinner with the President, Lynda, Luci & Lyn, Marie, Tom Johnson, Larry, and Jim.
