	6:30	President came into Oval Room looking for Mrs. J. Left second floor for Oval Room
	6:55	Departed Mansion for Pier One. In car with Mrs. J. Mr. and Mrs. Barefoot Sanders, Cong. and Mrs. Jack Brooks, Mrs. Pickle, Mary Rather Other guests besides those already listed were Susan Stevenson and LaFaye Davis. And the McHughes who were waiting for us at the Sequoia
	7:20	Arrived at dock and boarded Sequoia
	7:30	Mrs. J. to top deck shortly after boarding for sunshine and fresh air. Accompanied by Jake Pickle and Jack Brooks, Atty. Gen. and Mrs. Clark, Barefoot Sanders, Mr. and Mrs. Valenti
	7:45	Joined on deck by Mrs. Brooks and Mrs. Sanders. Few minutes later by Simon McHugh.
	8:10	Mr. and Mrs. Valenti went downstairs to talk to President
	9:00	Dinner Served on upper deck. Broiled lobster, roast beef with lettuce and tomato salad, string beans and something else.
	9:30	Movie shown to all but Mrs. J., Cong. and Mrs. Pickle and Mary Rather who went below and played bridge until boat docked at 10:10 pm
	10:10	President and Mrs. J. talking on rear deck to guests. Decided to stay on Sequoia and all guests left except Cong. and Mrs. Pickle, Mary Rather, Susan and LaFaye

	10:30	Called Mansion to send things for overnite stay on Sequoia, and to advise Lynda
	10:45	President and Mrs. J. and other guests to upper deck as Sequoia commenced tript down river again. Blankets needed as it was quite windy and cool. Watched movie.
	11:00	Weather turned to fine mist. Woke the President to tell him everyone going downstairs and he said "...anyone that went down stairs was a sissy." Everyone retired to downstairs.
	11:30	Watched TV news and Miss Universe contest and then late movie. President asleep in favorite chair on rear deck.
	12:00	Sequoia anchored in middle of river below Mount Vernon. Mrs. J. and all guests watched late movie to end.
	2:15	Everyone downstairs to bed.
