	9:32	Called the Kitchen for breakfast. Ate with the President in his room.
	10:15	Met with Ashton and Helene in the Library and later in the bedroom, going over mail breakdown.
	10:40	Dorothy Territo called.
	10:43	Called Betty Tilson at the White House.
	10:57	Haywood Smith called to say that the furniture would be down tomorrow.
	11:02	Jerry McKinney called.
	11:15	To the President's room.
	11:21	Called Okie (at the Ranch).
	12:45	To the pool with the President, Lynda, Luci, Lyn, and Marie (Jim Jones was there, but did not swim).
	1:45	Lunch in the dining room with the President, Lynda & Luci, Tom Johnson, Jim, Larry, Marie, Helene, and Ashton. Shrimp curry and trimmings, tossed salad with pineapple & pears, chocolate souffle with vanilla sauce. Hot homemade bread.
	2:41	Called Douglas Hubbard (in Washington) to see about filming at the Ranch over Labor Day <del>week</del> end -- learned it would be impossible.

	3:00	Left for Austin via chopper with Tom, Helene, Ashton, and Jerry McKinney.
	3:25	Arrived at Camp Mabry. Drove to KTBC -- to the 5th floor to see J. Kellam. Then to the 4th floor to see Cj's office -- measured furniture and wall space for office after January 20th. Roy White joined us here. Then returned to the 5th floor -- talked about plans for expanding 5th floor, and adding another room. Called Mme. Shoumatoff re coming this weekend to do the President's "ranch-type" portrait.
	6:00	Left by chopper with Helene, Ashton, and Woody Taylor.
	6:30	Returned to the Ranch. To the President's room right away to see Mayor Daley and Walter Cronkite on TV. (Very good!)
	7:25	Left the house with the President, Marie, Luci and Lyn for ride.
	8:20	Returned to the main house. Tom and Betty Weinheimer were already there; as was Father Schneider. We had cocktails in the front yard -- then came into the Living Room to see the nomination of VP Humphrey and Senator Muskie -- the Wisconsin delegation tried to place Julian Bond's name in nomination -- he received 61 votes before it was discovered that he is only 28! (Watching with us were Lynda, Luci, Lyn, Helene and Ashton -- other staff members ate and watched in the office.)
	9:30	Dinner on trays in Living Room: Turkey and dressing, beans, sweet potatoes. Listened to Senator Muskie's and VP Humphrey's speeches.

Midnight: raided refrigerator.  
1:30am Retired.
