Biographical sketch:

Welly K. Hopkins (1898-1994) was a friend of Lyndon B. Johnson. He served as General Counsel for the United Mine Workers of America.

Scope and content note:

This collection includes materials created and gathered by Welly K. Hopkins during his political and legal career. There is correspondence between Congressman Lyndon B. Johnson and Hopkins, along with legal correspondence and documents pertaining to Hopkins's dealings with A. J. Wirtz and John L. Lewis. The series also contains letters from Lady Bird Johnson and Lyndon B. Johnson.

There are documents and photographic materials created during Hopkins's career as General Counsel for the United Mine Workers of America (UMWA). These items include: professional portraits, wage agreements and negotiations, contracts, position papers, and his UMWA resignation letter.
