Creator: Tobriner, Walter Nathan, 1902-1979

Biographical sketch:

Walter Nathan Tobriner was a lawyer and law professor who served as United States Ambassador to Jamaica. Mr. Tobriner served on numerous boards and committees and was chairman of the National Housing Authority, chairman of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority, and a delegate to the Democratic National Conventions in 1956, 1960, and 1964.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of photocopies of documents from a scrapbook made by Walter N. Tobriner while he was a Commissioner for Washington, D.C. and Ambassador to Jamaica. They contain copies of certificates, transcripts of media broadcasts, invitations, correspondence, newspaper and magazine clippings, and photographs. The papers detail Mr. Tobriner's career, issues and events concerning Washington, D.C. including home rule, as well as U.S. relations with Jamaica.
