After leaving the White House, she worked with Stewart Udall and Governor Castro of New Mexico, as well as for the National Audubon Society and the Department of the Interior.

Wilson while she served in the White House Social Correspondence Office and as an aide to Lady Bird Johnson assisting with beautification projects.
