Biographical sketch:

Buck Hood was a longtime managing editor of the Austin American-Statesman newspaper in Austin, Texas. Hood also worked on Lyndon B. Johnson's 1941 Senate campaign, for the Democratic National Committee, was appointed to President John F. Kennedy's Committee for Traffic Safety in 1962, and helped arrange foreign visits for then President Lyndon B. Johnson.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Buck Hood while he was a campaign worker for Lyndon B. Johnson's 1941 campaign for the U.S. Senate. The documents include correspondence, notes and financial papers from the organization of different campaign events throughout Texas.
