## PERSONAL PAPERS OF ROBERT J. LAMPMAN

**Creator:** Lampman, Robert James, 1920-1997

### Biographical sketch:

Robert James Lampman was an economist and college professor. He entered the service as a naval air navigator in the Pacific during World War II. Mr. Lampman received a doctorate in labor economics from the University of Wisconsin. Lampman taught at the University of Washington for 10 years, and in 1958 he was appointed professor of economics at the University of Wisconsin. In 1962 Lampman was brought to Washington, D.C. to serve on President John F. Kennedy's Council of Economic Advisers. Lampman also wrote the chapter on poverty in the 1964 Economic Report of the President, which would become the blueprint for the Johnson Administration's anti-poverty initiative.

### Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Robert J. Lampman while he served as a consultant and staff member of the Council of Economic Advisers. The documents include correspondence and reports by Mr. Lampman on economics, poverty, wealth inequality, and unemployment.
