Biographical sketch:

Richard Lee Barton (b. July 24, 1925, -d. October 26, 1984) was a resident of Austin, Texas. He served in the United States Army from 1950 to 1951 and was married to Grace S. Barton. Barton is interred in Austin Memorial Park Cemetery in Austin, Texas.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of clippings from various Texas newspapers, the majority of which are about George L. Parr, his death, and his political activities in Duval County, Texas. There is also a smaller body of clippings about the 1975 trial of John Connally in which he was accused of selling influence.
