**Creator:** Asselta, Anthony Frank, 1919-1998

#### Biographical sketch:

Anthony Frank Asselta (b. March 24, 1919, Brooklyn, New York-d. November 10, 1998, Austin, Texas), who was in Europe in 1962, was a former security guard at the Lyndon Baines Johnson Presidential Library and a resident of Austin, Texas.

#### Scope and content note:

The Papers of Anthony F. Asselta consist of papers collected while he was a member of the U.S. Army serving in Europe. They contain diplomatic wireless files and newspaper clippings from the Daily Wireless File of the United States Information Service of the U.S. Embassy in Rome for September 4, 5, & 7, 1962. The documents are about Lyndon B. Johnson's trip to Italy and Greece in September of 1962 while he was Vice President and also contain transcripts of the speeches he made in Athens, Rome, and Naples.
