## PERSONAL PAPERS OF HOMER E. DEAN

**Creator:** Dean, Homer E., Jr., 1918-2008

### Biographical sketch:

Homer E. Dean, Jr., (b. September 18, 1918, Kaufman, Texas-d. August 18, 2008, Alice, Texas), lawyer, retired U.S. Army officer, served as Jim Wells County Attorney from 1947 to 1949 and District Attorney from 1950 to 1952. He served as Chairman of the Lyndon Johnson for Senator Committee in Jim Wells County during the 1948 senatorial election.

### Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Homer Dean while he served as Chairman of Lyndon B. Johnson's 1948 Senate Campaign in Jim Wells County, Texas. The papers consist of correspondence, lists of voters and volunteers, meeting minutes and resolutions, and newspaper clippings. Jim Wells was one of two counties contested by Coke Stevenson in the primary election due to an extremely close count and peculiar voting patterns.
