Biographical sketch:

Robert E. Waldron was a businessman and interior designer who served as a congressional assistant to J.J. Pickle, Homer Thornberry, and as an assistant to Lyndon B. Johnson from the time Johnson was in the Senate to his Vice-Presidency.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Robert E. Waldron while he was an aide to Vice President Lyndon B. Johnson. The papers consist of transcripts of two conferences of then Vice President Johnson and President Chiang Kai-Shek of the Republic of China. In the transcripts, the discussions reaffirm friendship and cooperation between the U.S. and Taiwan and highlight mutual security and economic concerns.
