Scope and content note:

The collection consists of documents and photographs assembled by Dorothy P. Territo in her capacity as a staff assistant to President Lyndon B. Johnson. Her primary responsibility was to collect material documenting President Johnson's family, his life, political campaigns, public service, and accomplishments as President. She functioned as a liaison between the Johnson White House and the National Archives and Records Service, which was then part of General Services Administration. She participated in planning for the establishment of the Lyndon Baines Johnson Library.

The collection has been divided into two series. Documentation and Working Files includes many original materials documenting the career of Lyndon B. Johnson, as well as working files used by Territo in conducting day to day business in the White House. The series pertains to a wide variety of topics related to Lyndon Johnson, his family, his career, and the Johnson administration, including the Presidential elections of 1960, 1964, and 1968; President Johnson's accomplishments, his statements, and his travel. The Post-Presidential Working Files contain material that Dorothy Territo maintained in her office while working at the Lyndon B. Johnson Library after leaving the White House staff in January 1969
