PERSONAL PAPERS OF HENRY CABOT LODGE

Creator: Lodge, Henry Cabot, 1902-1985

Biographical sketch:

Henry Cabot Lodge was a journalist, U.S. Senator, diplomat, and the grandson of statesman Henry Cabot Lodge, Sr. He served in Massachusetts legislature from 1932 to 1936, and was elected to the U.S. Senate in 1936 and 1946. Lodge served as Ambassador to the United Nations, Vietnam, and Germany; served as Chief negotiator at the Vietnam Peace Talks in Paris; and served as special envoy to the Vatican.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Henry Cabot Lodge while he served as the U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations (U.N.). The series contains copies of correspondence and speeches. The collection deals with then Senator Leader Lyndon B. Johnson's activities with the United Nations. They include remarks made by Johnson to and about the U.N., including his November, 1958 speech before the U.N. urging the peaceful use of outer space. Other topics include relations with the Soviet Union and disarmament.
