PERSONAL PAPERS OF JOSE MALDONADO

Creator: Maldonado, Jose 1904-2004

Biographical sketch:

Jose Maldonado was a physician. He attended Northwestern University at Evanston and Northwestern Medical School, graduating in 1931. Maldonado moved to Santa Fe, New Mexico in 1935 where he practiced medicine. He served as President of the League of United Latin American Citizens, and served in the United States Army during World War II.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Jose Maldonado that are related to his service as a volunteer for the Viva Johnson campaign. The papers consist of correspondence, photographs, newspaper clippings and memorabilia pertaining to Lyndon B. Johnson's 1964 presidential campaign, the 1965 inauguration, and a 1967 White House dinner for Mexican President Gustavo Díaz Ordaz.
