Bell Helicopter, founded in 1935, is an American aerospace manufacturer headquartered in Fort Worth, Texas. A division of Textron, Bell manufactures military rotorcraft and provides training and support services worldwide.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of correspondence, award certificates, newspaper clippings, and photographs that describe Lyndon B. Johnson's use of rotary aircraft for transportation and give recognition from Bell Helicopter to Johnson for his use of helicopters. The papers also include letters from Lyndon B. Johnson to Joe Mashman, who was a Bell employee and Johnson's helicopter pilot during his 1948 Senate campaign.
