PERSONAL PAPERS OF ABRAM V. GOODMAN

Creator: Goodman, Abram Vossen, 1903-2002

Biographical sketch:

Rabbi Abram Vossen attended Roxbury Latin School and graduated from Harvard University in 1924. Goodman received a Masters of Hebrew Literature from the Jewish Institute of Religion and was ordained as a rabbi in 1928. He also studied at Hebrew University, the American School of Oriental Research in Jerusalem, and received a Ph.D. from the University of Texas at Austin. Goodman served as a rabbi in Austin, Texas; Davenport, Iowa; and Long Island, New York.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Abram V. Goodman while he served as a Rabbi in Austin, Texas. The papers contain correspondence in German, Spanish, and English, translations, and a magazine article. The papers concern the failed attempt to get Abram's Jewish cousin, who later perished in the Holocaust, emigrated from Germany just prior to World War II.
