Scope and content note:

This collection consists of files created and/or maintained by Fred Bohen during his time on the White House domestic policy staff in the Lyndon B. Johnson administration. The collection includes bound Federal and Social Program Summaries (1966) for each state. There are also drafts, memorandums, clippings, and copies of program proposals sent to Congress from the White House that outline legislative programs. There are memorandums, reports, maps, organizational charts, handwritten notes, and printed material from Bohen's participation on the President's Task Force on Government Organizations.

The materials reflect the involvement of external academics and experts who worked on the Task Force to implement ideas for Johnson's Great Society. The collection also includes reports, papers, and remarks from the Bureau of the Budget, the Department of Commerce, Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Office of Economic Opportunity, and the Department of Transportation. There is also material from the 1968 campaign, and Bohen's handwritten notes taken while on work-related trips.
