Dorothy Jackson Nichols (b. 1913, Cotulla, Texas; d. 1990 Washington, D.C.) was a secretary who worked for Lyndon B. Johnson since his first term in Congress through his Presidency. She was married to Federal Judge Philip Nichols.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Dorothy Nichols, secretary to then Congressman Lyndon B. Johnson. The papers contain a manuscript by Nichols describing her experiences working for Johnson in his Washington, D.C. office and in Johnson City, Texas.
