PERSONAL PAPERS OF LUTHER E. JONES

Creator: Jones, Luther Edward, Jr., 1914-1999

Biographical sketch:

Luther Edward Jones, Jr., also known as L. E., was a lawyer. Jones attended Central High School in Houston, Texas, where he was on the debate team led by Lyndon B. Johnson. After graduation he attended the Rice Institute for two years before moving to Washington, D.C. in 1934 to work in the office of Congressman Richard Kleberg alongside Johnson. He served under Johnson at the National Youth Administration, and also worked on Johnson's 1937 campaign.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Luther E. Jones related to his work as an assistant to Congressman Richard Kleberg and his association with Lyndon B. Johnson. The papers contain copies of correspondence from Lyndon Johnson that discuss activities in Congressman Richard Kleberg's office. Many are cordial in nature and discuss Jones' career. There is also a letter written by Mr. Jones that relates his memories of Lyndon Johnson.
